[Out of 11 teams that participated 5 went on to the END GAME]

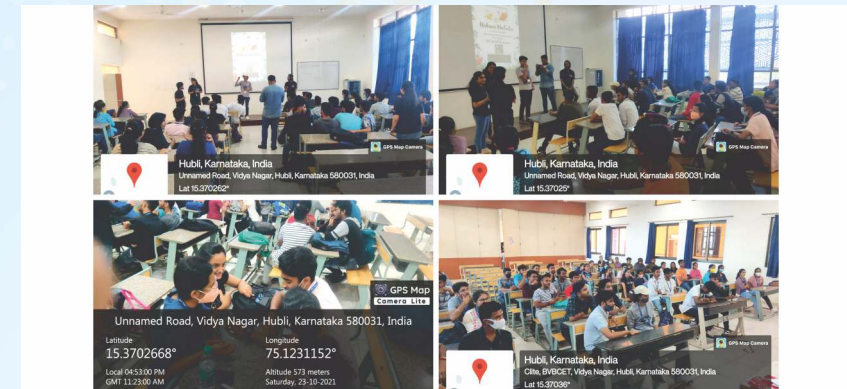
Event 4 - END GAME





Legal Literacy Program

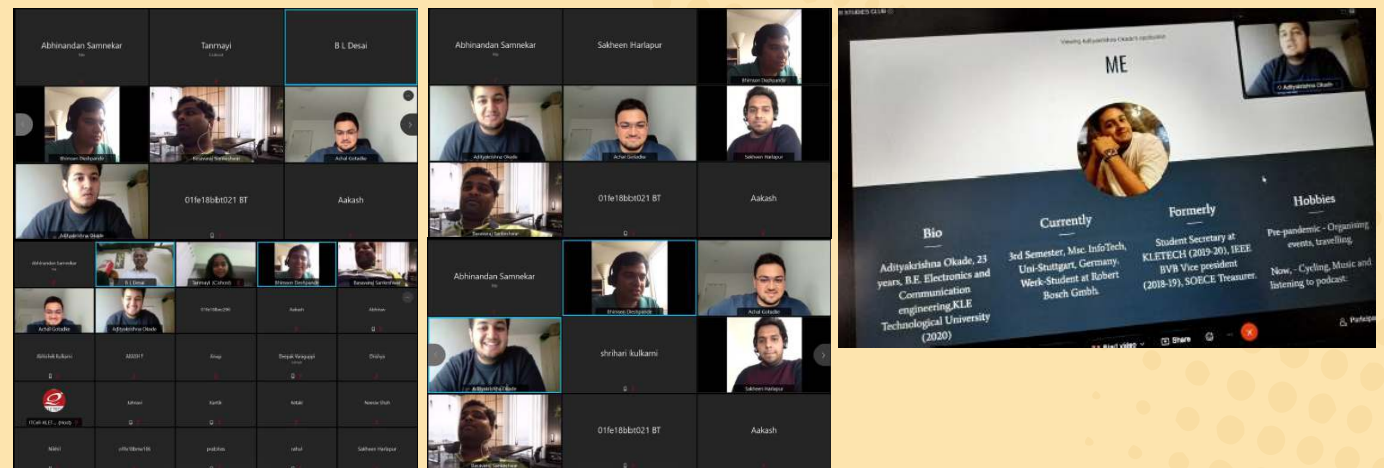


Human Rights Day



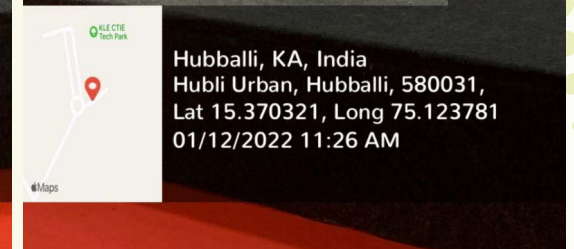
